NEW AND RETURNING BUYERS

- Each 4-H exhibitor will be eligible to sell only one market beef, one market sheep, one market goat, and one market swine.
- The Northwest Kansas District Free Fair Board has determined that if an animal goes through the sale that it is not to be made available for re-sale. What happens to the animal is to be the first choice of the buyer (ship to sale barn, send to a locker, or take home). Any corrections or questions should be dealt with only after the conclusion of the sale.
- If you are wanting to process an animal, it is advised to make an appointment with your preferred locker earlier rather than later. This is a very busy time of year for lockers and available space fills up fast.
- 2024 4-H Livestock Sale Order Swine, Sheep, Beef, Goat (Grand and reserve champions of all species will sell at the beginning of the 4-H Livestock Sale).
- Market animals will be released and shipped at the discretion of the superintendent.
- Sale Bill Availability (floor prices published on sale bill):
 - Hand delivered by 4-H exhibitors to previous year buyers the morning of the 4-H Livestock Sale. Please contact the Extension Office at 785-890-4880 to be added to the list.
 - o Home Page of NWKS Fair Website (<u>www.nwksfair.com</u>).
 - Prior to the start of the 4-H Livestock Sale.
- The day of the 4-H Livestock Sale please check-in at the announcer stand to confirm contact information and receiver your bidder number.
- The Northwest Kansas District Free Fair collects a 0% commission.
- Announcements sale day take precedence over printed material.

• After the conclusion of the Northwest Kansas District Free Fair, paperwork will be provided to the 4-H'ers. They will contact you directly to get a check for their animal. This allows them to personally thank you for your purchase.
